



Agenda: Consider establishment of San Angelo ISD Long Range Facilities Planning Committee

Goal of the LRFPC

The goal of the LRFPC is to involve constituents of San Angelo Independent School District in evaluating current and long-term facility needs.

Purpose of the LRFPC

The purpose of the LRFPC is to provide facility and equipment recommendations to San Angelo ISD Board of Trustees after having studied current facilities, educational programs, student population trends associated with the school district, and other data relevant to providing quality educational programs for all students.

Charges to the Committee

The LRFPC represents all stakeholders of San Angelo Independent School District and is asked to provide meaningful information to the district by developing recommendations that:

- Considers the educational needs of all students
- Provides an adequate and appropriate learning environment
- Is fiscally sound
- Reflects community values and perceptions of need
- Are based on current, relevant data and best practices

Parameters for the LRFPC

- The LRFPC will be comprised of individuals from the community who represent the diversity and complex interests within San Angelo ISD and aided by district staff members serving as information providers for the committee.
- Explore possible opportunities to address current and long-term facility needs in accordance with the following guiding priorities:
 - Building age, safety and condition
 - District growth and capacity
 - Evolving educational delivery



- The LRFPC will report findings to the Board including, but not limited to, recommendations as to how to proceed with a long-range plan. Recommendation(s) should address immediate and future facility needs of the school district to the extent members feel are financially prudent.
- The LRFPC will have access to data and resources provided by San Angelo ISD to develop appropriate facility recommendations.
- The LRFPC recognizes that the committee's role is to provide recommendations to the Board of Trustees of San Angelo ISD and that the Board of Trustees will determine how to proceed with a long-range plan and the appropriate funding source.
- The LRFPC agrees to communicate progress and submit information requests to the school district in a timely fashion and provide regular updates to San Angelo ISD and the community.

Timeline for LRFPC Recommendations

A timeline for the work of the LRFPC is requested by the school district that will include committee recommendations to be delivered to the Board of Trustees no later than early February 2018.

Proposed Action: Approve the establishment of a long-range facilities planning committee. Request for a timeline of work to be provided prior to convening the committee.
